Daily email from class teacher to inform about the day.

KS2 Gives a clear overview of what students have done Helps to give parents an idea of what mood child will be in when they return home Parents rely on the daily email, often it arrives before the child gets home.

KS2 A standard format:-

Overview of lessons throughout the day
What went right and what went wrong for the child
How the class have been generally – has anything
occurred that could impact on how the child feels.
Year 7 and 8 – Emails can be quite generic. Can the
students attitudes to learning be commented on.
Could an app be used instead of the email?

School dinners and parent communication – is there an app available that can collate all information provided for parents?

Consider a guide for staff to help to structure the email and know what needs to be included.

Can feedback on interventions taking place throughout the day be included.

Year 10 – Email can be quite generic – more about what child did rather than how he did it.

We'd like more specific information about how the day went. More focus on praise and celebrations. We rely on the email.
