


The Land of Roar Jenny McLachlan


The Reluctant Dragon Kenneth Grahame


Fantastic Mr Fox Roald Dahl


Coming to England Floella Benjamin




Artemis Fowl Eoin Coife



Clockwork Philip Pullman




Tick, tock, tick, tock! Some stories are like that. Once you've wend them up, nothing will stop them ...


Pig Heart Boy Malorie Blackman



Soon it isn't only Budi's dreams at stake, but his life.


The Wolves of Willoughby Chase Joan Aiken


What's worse than hiding a secret?

Chinese Cinderella Adeline Yen Mah




